I am delighted to present employment outcomes for graduates of the MASc Supply Chain Management Class of 2024.

The demand for experienced supply chain talent last year did not abate, despite shifts in various sectors of the economy. A notable difference from 2023, however, was a more cautious approach to hiring – particularly among our traditional consulting employers. Overall, employers became more active as the academic year progressed. Job postings, company visits, interviews and offers accelerated during spring semester. This was particularly true of our traditional technology employers that comprised nearly 70% of accepted offers.

The outstanding results in this report were made possible by the unwavering support that the SCM program received from its global alumni base. Their willingness to advise and counsel students, visit campus, post positions and extend offers was evidenced by the 74% of students who attributed their employment to SCM/MIT alumni.

SCM alumni have always been our greatest asset – a lifelong network that is immensely loyal to the SCM Program. 


